The RE department are pleased to announce that we are running a trip to the National Justice Museum in Nottingham on Friday 2nd December 2022. This is an exciting opportunity for pupils to understand the importance of the judicial system in the United Kingdom as well as the history of Crime and Punishment.

During this trip students will examine a case and then prepare and present a trial based on the evidence available by playing the roles of judge, jury, defence and prosecution. At the end of the trial students will reach a verdict and discuss sentencing options. Students will spend time in the emotive capital punishment gallery, take part in a facilitated debate, meet historical prison characters and hear their stories of capital punishment.

This trip will support students with their oracy, leadership, public speaking and problem solving skills. This trip also supports the 'Crime and Punishment' topic that students are currently studying in RE lessons.

Pupils need to meet at the main reception by 8:30am so we can leave school at 9.00am. We aim to leave the museum at 2:00 pm and arrive back to school for around 3.30pm.

The cost of this trip is £21 and it is payable on ParentPay. This price includes the coach journey and two workshops that students will be attending at the National Justice Museum. There are a limited number of spaces available and therefore this will be allocated on a **first come, first served**, basis.

Please be advised that pupils will need to bring any medication with them and this must be in date – any pupil who does not bring in-date medication will not be allowed on the trip.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch (students in receipt of Free School Meals will have one provided) and will be in school uniform.
